There will not be any labs on the first week of the semester.

You will be doing labs every other week since there are many students and not enough lab rooms.

It means that students from odd sections (801, 803, 805, etc.) are going to do labs in the week of Sept. 9, while students from even sections won't have labs that week.

Then, next week roles will be flipped: students from even sections (802, 804, 806, etc.) will be doing labs and students from odd sections won't have labs.

You will see these abbreviations:

RO-1: It means odd sections, which are scheduled to do labs on Thursdays, will do the Experiment 1 (M1 Period of an Oscillating Ring, see the bottom of the schedule page)

TE-1: It means even sections, which are scheduled to do labs on Tuesdays, will do the Experiment 1 (M1 Period of an Oscillating Ring, see the bottom of the schedule page)

RE-1: It means even sections, which are scheduled to do labs on Thursdays, will do the Experiment 1 (M1 Period of an Oscillating Ring, see the bottom of the schedule page)

And so on.
