



Using Mirroring 360 on Campus with an iPad

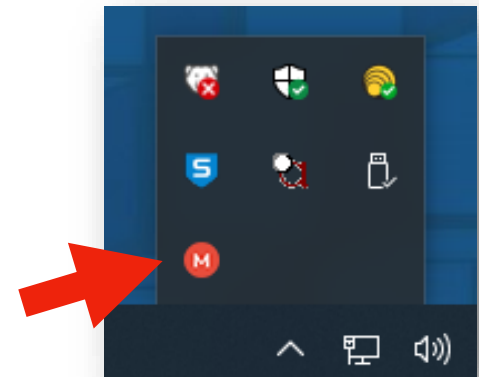
1 - First, your iPad will need to have a profile installed to be able to join the UML eduroam Wifi network. If you have a VTR iPad (one supplied via UML IT), click the following icon for instructions:



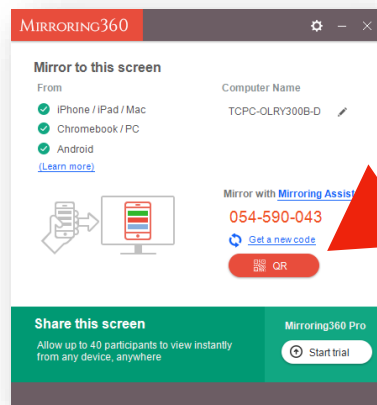

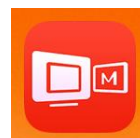
2 - On the Teacher's PC in the classroom, click the ^ icon on the bottom right corner, and click on the "M" icon to launch Mirroring 360.



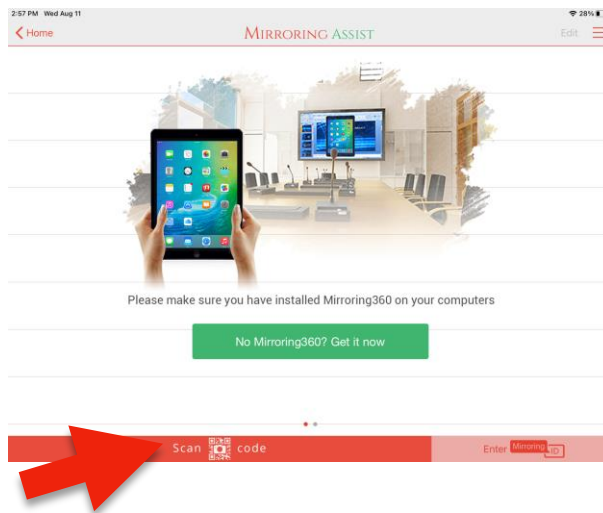
3 - Click the QR CODE icon:



4 - On the iPad, launch the Mirroring Assist app.



5 - After the Mirroring Assist application opens, select “Scan QR Code” button in bottom left.



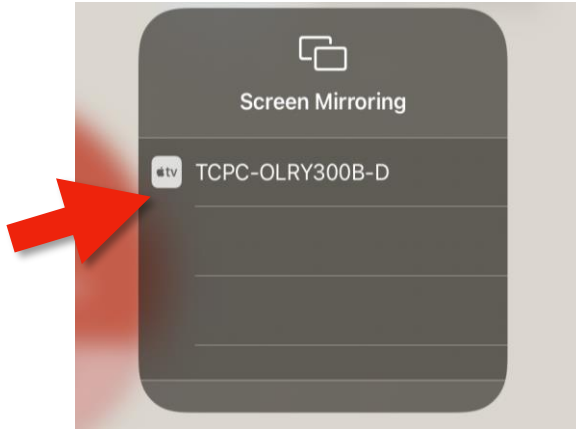
6 - With the iPad, scan the QR code on PC screen.

7 - On the iPad, with one finger, pull down from the top right corner and select “Screen Mirroring”.

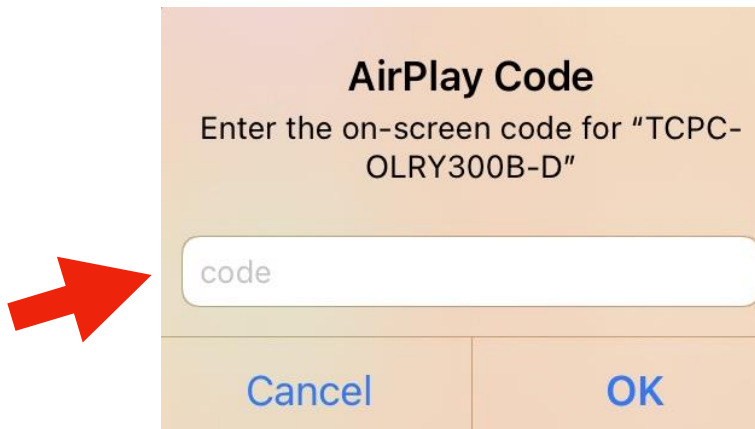


8 - Select the TCPC teacher's podium PC. This name changes according to the room's location.

9 – After a slight delay, enter the numeric code shown on the PC into the iPad and hit “OK”.



10 - Remember to select “Stop Mirroring” from the iPad pull down menu when you are do done.
